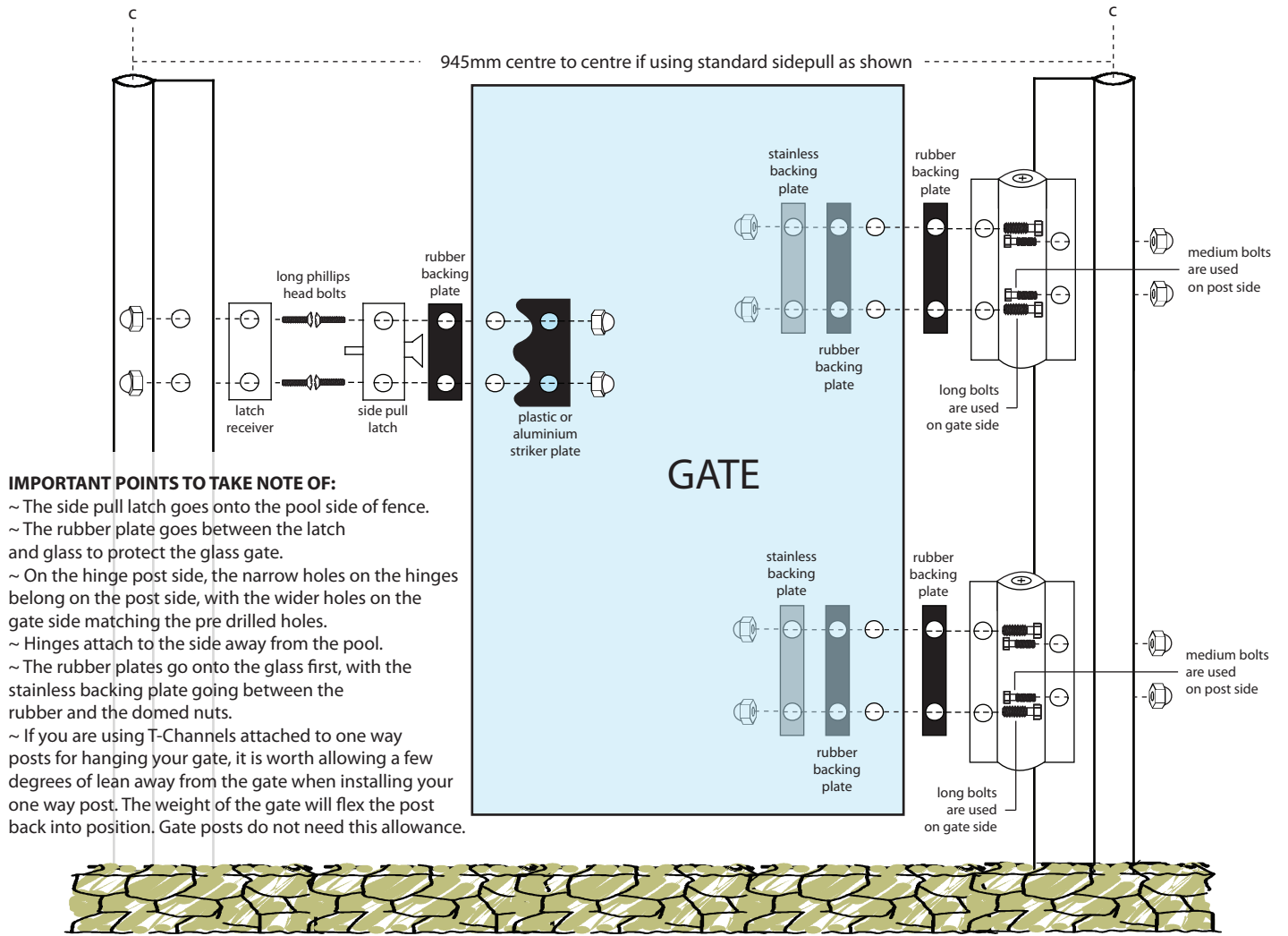
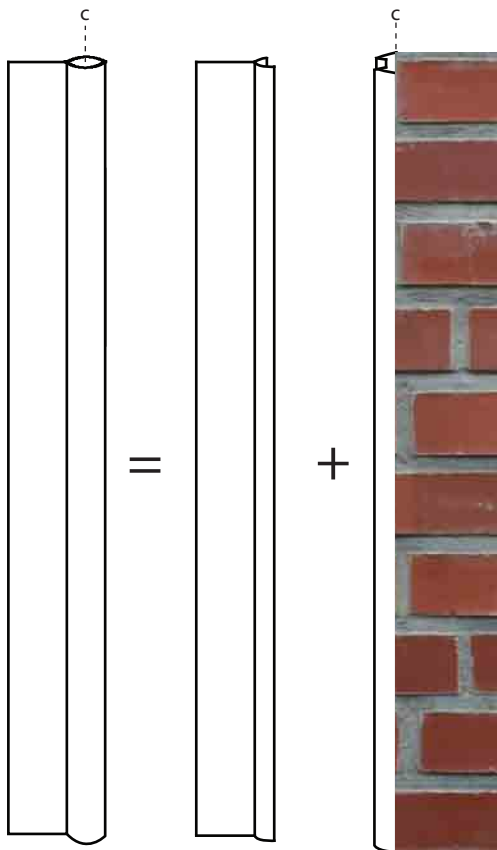


Standard Gate Assembly Diagram

Standard Gate Assembly Procedure

- 1) Attach the hinges to the gate panel as shown in the diagram above.
- 2) Put two wooden blocks on the ground and then shim the gate up on these blocks until the gate is level with the glass in the rest of the fenceline. Rubber doorstops can work well for this procedure as you can tap them in to gain height.
- 3) Ensure that the gaps on either side of the gate are approximately 10mm and are fairly even on both sides.
- 4) Mark on the hinge gate post the positions of the holes that will attach the hinges to the gate post using the attached hinges as your template for the holes.
- 5) Drill the holes into your hinge gate post in the positions you have marked.
- 6) Tension your hinges using the hidden adjustor inside the hinge. You access this by removing the top of the hinge with a screwdriver. To change the tension push down on the mechanism and turn it.
- 7) Put the gate back in position and secure it to your hinge gate post.
- 8) Attach the side pull magna latch as shown above on the latch post side. Ensure the unlocking mechanism is on the pool side.
- 9) If necessary, attach the no toe hold cap into the top of the hinges to prevent them being used as a foothold for climbing.
